REMINDER: PA Tax Amnesty Program is Ending on June 18th

This is just a reminder that the PA Tax Amnesty program is currently open but the program will end June 18, 2010. All delinquent forms must be filed and payments must be made by June 18th to be eligible for amnesty. Individuals, businesses and other entities with Pennsylvania tax delinquencies as of June 30, 2009, are generally eligible to participate in the amnesty program. Any delinquent PA taxes that were due for the period June 30, 2009 or prior qualify for the program (for example: individual income taxes, corporate income taxes, sales & use tax, employer withholding taxes, and other taxes) .

Amnesty provides for an abatement of 100% of penalties and 50% of the late interest charges. Amounts due to PA can be paid in several payments so long as the entire balance due is paid by June 18, 2010. In very rare cases, the PA Dept of Revenue may allow the taxpayer to enter into a brief installment agreement that extends beyond June 18, 2010.

Failure to pay any taxes and file delinquent returns via the amnesty program will result in an additional 5% penalty, if the State assesses and/or collects delinquent taxes from you after June 18, 2010.
